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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Expressed suicidal or homicidal thoughts (if urgent threat, call 911 or Campus Safety for ER transport)• Major Life Event in Student's Life (death of a loved one, house fire, significant break-up)• Mental Health, Emotional, or Behavioral Concerns | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recent mental health hospitalization• Relationship Concerns• Student Repeatedly Missing Classes• Title IX-Related Experience• Uncharacteristic Behavior |
