## **Addendum to the Annual Report to the Faculty 2019-2020**

The purpose of this addendum is two-fold: first, to address the German and German Studies Department's proposal submission; and second, to update information regarding postponed searches.

CAP's Annual Report to the faculty (April 8, 2020) reported that the German and German Studies Department "declined to continue with proposals after submitting letters of intent..." (page 4). However, after consultation with the Chair of the German and German Studies Department, Qinna Shen, CAP revises the report: "Due to a miscommunication, CAP did not receive a full proposal from the German and German Studies Department."

In addition, CAP's Annual Report noted that "CAP began exploring the possibility of limiting the number of searches conducted in any given year" (page 3). We asked six departments whose search requests were recommended – Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, English, Political Science, and Psychology – to consider postponing their search for one year. The English Department and the Political Science Department agreed to do so.
